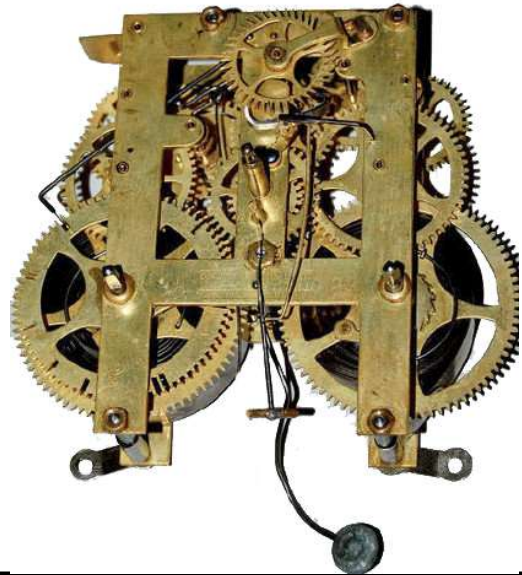


190-1A - The American Count Wheel Striking Clock

- You should bring some form of magnification such as; eye loupe, clip on loupe, optivisor, etc.
- You will learn how the count wheel controls the strike hammer on the hour and half hour.
- You will completely disassemble and reassemble the entire clock including the mainsprings.
- You will learn how to make adjustments to the strike train to make it run properly, if required.
- You will understand how the most popular, and reliable American style movement operates.
